## Workshop on Art & Science of Online Literature Search

On Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2018 the College Conference Committee organized a lecture for faculty members by Dr.Santosh Hulagabali on the topic 'Art and Science of Online Literature Search' from 8am to 11am. Dr.Santosh Hulagabali works as a Librarian at Nagindas Khandwala College (Autonomous) Mumbai. The lecture began with a welcome speech delivered by Dr.Mukhta Manoj following which; there was an introduction on the profile of the guest speaker by Ms. Vaishali Dawar. The principal Dr.Parag Ajgaonkar addressed the faculty members present and felicitated the guest speaker.

Dr.Santosh Hulagabali started the session by briefly explaining the concept of scholarly data and then further explained the fundamentals of how to source such data online. He enlightened the participants on different types of search approaches like PICO search technique, Phrase search technique, file type technique etc.

He also informed the participants to beware of predatory journals and the dangers of plagiarism. The lecture gave ample information on online sources and tools like MOOC, Edx, youtube, classtube, online archives of indexing database etc. which can be used for organising lectures and for research purposes. The session ended with some motivating tips thus encouraging the teachers to become academic celebrities. Mr. Conrad Coelho proposed the vote of thanks. The 26 faculty members present were given certificates of participation. The lecture was very informative and educational and helped the faculty members to understand on how to use online tools effectively while writing research papers and also greatly benefited those who are currently pursuing PhD.
